

FYI DIAPERING IN BATHROOM

As part of the Toddler Room’s policy for potty training it may be possible that your child will be changed in the bathroom. They will not be laid down to be changed, we actually change them while they are standing. If they have a very messy diaper they will be taken back to the room where the changing table is.

As you are aware the Toddler Room is where the potty training begins and is completed. We have found that taking the children to the bathroom on a regular schedule will enable this task to be accomplished. When a child is in the bathroom and has either a diaper or a pull-up on we do take it off of them (in the bathroom area) so they can use the potty. If at that time when they either show interest or not we wait and then we need to re-diaper or re-pull-up them, and this will also be done in the bathroom, unless very messy. We store your child’s diapers and pull-ups in the bathroom for this reason. This is also why you may see us changing children in the bathroom. We have found this the best way to potty train.
